

## VIII. POOL RULES

- a. No towel snapping, running, shoving, dunking or rough play of any kind allowed.
- b. No profanity! We encourage a polite family atmosphere.
- c. No smoking outside of the designated area.
- d. No floats allowed, except approved lifejackets and child arm floats with adult supervision. The use of flippers, goggle mask, and snorkel must have prior approval of lifeguards.
- e. No food or drinks allowed in the pool. This includes cans, bottles and Styrofoam containers.
- f. No talking to lifeguards while they are on duty.
- g. No diving or jumping from the sides of diving boards. Only one person is permitted on diving boards at a time.
- h. Proper swimwear is required. No jeans, cut-offs, or thongs allowed.
- i. Admission may be refused to person(s) with infections, rashes, or contagious disease.
- j. Anyone under the influence of alcohol or drugs will not be admitted.
- k. Person(s) with excessive sunburn or bandages of any kind will not be permitted in the pool.
- l. A 10 minute break will occur every hour. Only adults 18 years and older are allowed in the pool during this time. Pre-school children will be permitted to swim with the adults in the shallow end; only one child per adult.
- m. Children under 18 years of age must pass a swimming test before being allowed in the diving area.
- n. Only nerf-type balls are allowed in the pool.
- o. No one may use the pool unless it is officially open and lifeguards are on duty.
- p. Public display of affection is not permitted!!
- q. There will be no swimming during inclement weather.
- r. The Gallipolis Municipal Swimming Pool employees and/or management are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Rental bags are available for \$0.25 at the admission desk.
- s. The Gallipolis Municipal Swimming Pool personnel have the authority to enforce all rules in order to ensure all patrons enjoy a safe, clean and fun atmosphere. Anyone not adhere to pool policies will be reprimanded appropriately.
- t. Pool management reserves the right to decide all matters not covered above pool rules.
