

ORDINANCE NO. O2018-27

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND
REJECTING BIDS FOR THE MILLING AND
PAVING OF VARIOUS CITY STREETS**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2017-04, passed by the City Commission on November 14, 2017, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for the milling and paving of various City streets.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Monday, August 6, 2018, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of The Shelly Company is the lowest and most responsible bid for a portion of the milling and paving of various City streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of The Shelly Company, 80 Park Drive, Thornville, Ohio, is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for a portion of the milling and paving of various City streets, and the said bid as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.


SECTION 1: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to The Shelly Company for 20% of the project cost not to exceed \$46,807.00 and the remaining 80% to be paid by the Ohio Public Works Commission not to exceed \$187,227.00


SECTION 2: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.


