

ORDINANCE NO. O2018-30

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
BANDSTAND RESTORATION**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2017-04, passed by the City Commission on November 14, 2017, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for the bandstand restoration.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, August 21, 2018, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of Saunders Contracting, LLC is the lowest and most responsible bid for the bandstand restoration; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of Saunders Contracting LLC, 402 Fourth Avenue, Gallipolis, Ohio, is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for the bandstand restoration, and the said as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Saunders Contracting, LLC in the amount of \$35,260.00.

SECTION 2: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
