Brandstetter Carroll was the first to present its qualifications for design of the new municipal building. Their firm, located in Cincinnati, is one of the largest architectural firms in the country. Panich & Noel Architects of Athens presented next. They have a staff of eighteen, including architects, designers, engineers, draftsmen, and managers. They would plan to begin construction in early 2010.
