The Gallipolis City Commission met in special budgetary work session on Saturday, February 6, 2010, at 12:00 p.m. in the City Manager's Office of the Gallipolis Municipal Building, having complied with Section 9 of the City Charter.

Commission President James Cozza called the meeting to order and gave the invocation.

Mr. Cremeens made a motion to allow sewer connections for the five or six homes in the Spring Valley area that the City Manager had mentioned at an earlier meeting. The motion was seconded by Mr. Johnson. In response to a question about who would pay the cost of connection, Mr. Finney stated that all of the costs of connection would be the responsibility of the property owners making connection. In response to a question about the amount of flow, Mr. Finney said that the amount of flow should be minimal, since these are residential hook-ups. The flow will be gravity fed. Upon voice vote on the motion, all votes were yes.

The Commission continued discussions of the 2010 proposed budget. Questions arising from these discussions were delayed to a special budgetary work session set for February 16, 2010, at 6:30 p.m.

There being no further business to come before the City Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
