

ORDINANCE NO. O2015-35

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2007-54,
AS AMENDED BY O2013-02,
AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PAYMENTS FROM
WATER, WATER POLLUTION CONTROL,
AND SANITATION FUNDS OF GALLIPOLIS
TO THE GENERAL, M & R STREETS, WATER AND WATER POLLUTION
CONTROL FUNDS OF GALLIPOLIS FOR SERVICES PROVIDED

WHEREAS, the City Commission, based upon information from the City Manager, is desirous of recovering the cost of equipment furnished and services rendered by the City officials and employees to said departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the following sections which read as follows:

SECTION 2: That the City's Sanitation Department Fund pay to the General, Water and Water Pollution Control Funds from its revenues per month as an administrative service charge an amount based upon the following formula:

Sanitation Administrative Costs:

Water Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 30\%$.

Sewer Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 17.5\%$.

General Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 17.5\%$.

If any month's Sanitation expenditures exceed Sanitation Revenues, the excess will be carried over to the following month's calculation.

SECTION 3: That the City Sanitation Department Fund pay to the M & R Streets Fund of the City of Gallipolis from its revenues per month as an administrative service charge an amount based upon the following formula:

Sanitation litter charges:

$(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 35\%$. If any month's Sanitation expenditures exceed Sanitation Revenues, the excess will be carried over to the following month's calculation.

BE, AND HEREBY ARE, AMENDED to read as follows:

SECTION 2: That the City's Sanitation Department Fund pay to the General, Water and Water Pollution Control Funds from its revenues per month as an administrative service charge an amount based upon the following formula:

Sanitation Administrative Costs:

Water Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 10\%$.

Sewer Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 10\%$.

General Fund: $(\text{Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures}) \times 10\%$.

If any month's Sanitation expenditures exceed Sanitation Revenues, the excess will be carried over to the following month's calculation.

SECTION 3: That the City Sanitation Department Fund pay to the M & R Streets Fund of the City of Gallipolis from its revenues per month as an administrative service charge an amount based upon the following formula:

Sanitation litter charges:

(Monthly Sanitation Revenue minus Monthly Sanitation Expenditures) x 70%. If any month's Sanitation expenditures exceed Sanitation Revenues, the excess will be carried over to the following month's calculation.


Section 2: That this Ordinance hereby repeals all previous ordinances setting sanitation administrative costs.


Section 3: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants as herein provided.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
