

ORDINANCE NO. O2016-42

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CITY MANAGER TO AUTHORIZE AND FUND
CHANGE ORDER NO. 6 AND CHANGE ORDER NO. 7
WITH MECHANICAL CONSTRUCTION CO. INC.
FOR MODIFICATIONS FOR THE
WATER POLLUTION CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept change orders on the original contract for the construction of the Water Pollution Control Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into the attached Change Order No. 6 for a reduced amount of \$77,193.00 due to exceeding the contract completion date and Change Order No. 7 for an additional amount of \$38,385.29 for modifications at the Water Pollution Control Facility.


SECTION 2: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to reduce her draws for said Change Order Nos. 6 & 7 to Mechanical Construction Co. Inc., 2302 8th Street, Portsmouth, Ohio 45662, for an amount not to exceed Thirty-Eight Thousand Eight Hundred Seven and 71/100 Dollars (\$38,807.71) at the direction of the City Manager, as per Change Order Nos. 6 & 7, which are attached hereto and made part of this Ordinance as if fully written herein.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
