

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-05

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH
OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ROAD SALT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R2007-21 passed by the City Commission on November 20, 2007, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for highway de-icing salt; and

WHEREAS, due to the lack of availability of road salt in the State of Ohio, the City received no bids for highway de-icing salt; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Transportation has offered to enter into agreement with the city to provide road salt at a cost of \$75.00 per ton, not to exceed 200 tons; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with the Ohio Department of Transportation to purchase road salt at a cost of \$75.00 per ton, not to exceed 200 tons, as per attached agreement.


SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Ohio Department of Transportation not to exceed \$15,000.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.




