

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-15

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
CHEMICALS AND QUICKLIME**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2008-18 passed by the City Commission on November 18, 2008, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for chemicals and quicklime.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Thursday, February 26, 2009, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of five of the six companies that submitted competitive bids are the lowest and most responsible bid for a portion of the supplies contained within the bid list; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of the companies listed in Section 1 are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids for chemicals and quicklime, and the said as incorporated hereinabove are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That the following companies:

- (1) Sal Chemical, 3036 Birch Drive, Weirton, WV 26062;
- (2) Brenntag Mid-South Inc., 319 First Street North, St. Albans, WV 25177
- (3) Greer Lime Company, P. O. Box 1900, Morgantown, WV 26507-1900;
- (4) The C. I. Thornburg Co., 4034 Altizer Avenue, Huntington, WV 25705;
- (5) Bonded Chemicals, 2645 Charter Street, Columbus, OH 43228;

be awarded a contract for line items as per attached bid tabulation. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.


SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Sal Chemical, Brenntag Mid-South Inc., Greer Lime Company, The C. I. Thornburg Co., and Bonded Chemicals.


SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure with contract beginning April 1, 2009.
