**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O2009-08,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2009-12,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2009-13,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2009-16,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2009-24,
SETTING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO,
DURING THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2009**

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Ordinance No. O2009-08, as amended by Ordinance No. O2009-12, as amended by Ordinance No. O2009-13, as amended by Ordinance No. O2009-16, as amended by Ordinance No. O2009-24, to appropriate necessary funds for the General Fund and the New Municipal Building Fund; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the following sections be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 13: 101.272 City Building from \$67,695.00 to \$72,313.00

SECTION 20: 101.920 Transfers/Advances from \$555,305.48 to \$1,561,305.48

SECTION 22: TOTAL GENERAL FUND from \$3,473,719.28 to \$4,484,337.28

SECTION 26: 242.445 Cemeteries from \$150,888.30 to \$186,888.30

SECTION 47: TOTAL SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS from \$1,805,719.28 to \$1,841,719.28

SECTION 49: 340.970 New Municipal Building from \$30,000.00 to \$325,000.00

SECTION 55: TOTAL CAPITAL PROJECTS FUNDS from \$1,803,628.97 to \$2,098,628.97


SECTION 89: TOTAL ALL FUNDS from \$11,332,085.64 to \$12,673,703.64

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


