

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-30

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A COPS
(COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES) GRANT
FOR THE GALLIPOLIS COMMUNICATION INTEROPERABILITY PROJECT
AND TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT IF AWARDED**

WHEREAS, funding is available through the U. S. Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS); and

WHEREAS, funding is available for radios for wireless communications for the Gallipolis Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Appropriations Act 2009 has funding available that may be used for the Gallipolis Communication Interoperability Project if grant criteria is met; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis desires to apply for such funds before the June 22, 2009 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to make application for radios for wireless communications and enter into agreement if funded for said COPS (Community Oriented Policing Services) grant funds for the Gallipolis Communication Interoperability Project for \$250,000.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
