

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-55

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADDING AN ADDENDUM TO AN
EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT WITH C. JOSEPH WOODALL AND
ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF C. JOSEPH WOODALL AS CITY MANAGER**

WHEREAS, The City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, and C. Joseph Woodall entered into an employment agreement as incorporated into Ordinance O2008-14; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, and C. Joseph Woodall desire to supplement the employment agreement executed on March 18, 2008 and incorporated into Ordinance O2008-14; and

WHEREAS, C. Joseph Woodall desires to resign as City of Manager of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, effective immediately.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Commission hereby authorizes the signing of an Addendum to the employment agreement with C. Joseph Woodall incorporated into Ordinance O2008-14.

SECTION 2: That the City Commission hereby accepts the resignation of C. Joseph Woodall as City Manager effective immediately.


SECTION 3: All previous Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, setting compensation and vacation for the City Manager are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.

**ADDENDUM TO CITY MANAGER'S EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO, AND C. JOSEPH WOODALL,
ENTERED INTO ON MARCH 18, 2008**

This Addendum, made and entered into this 22nd day of September, 2009, by and between City of Gallipolis, an Ohio Municipal Corporation, hereinafter known as "City", and C. Joseph Woodall, hereinafter known as "Woodall".

WHEREAS, the City and Woodall wish to amend the City Manager's Employment Agreement entered into on March 18, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Woodall wishes to resign as City Manager and the parties agree to waive the thirty (30) day notice requirement.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

SECTION 1: TERM: The parties agree the employment agreement as City Manager shall terminate upon the signing hereof.

SECTION 2: The parties agree to waive the 30 day notice to resign. Further, the parties agree Woodall shall be re-employed with the City as Project Coordinator/Safety Director for a period of three (3) years beginning September 23, 2009, and ending September 22, 2012. This position shall be considered part-time. The parties further agree Woodall may be removed from Project Coordinator/Safety Director for just cause.


