

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-60

**AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
HIGHWAY DE-ICING SALT, CALCIUM CHLORIDE, AND COLD MIX**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2008-18 passed by the City Commission on November 18, 2008, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for highway de-icing salt, calcium chloride, and cold mix.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Tuesday, September 8, 2009, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bids of the three companies that submitted competitive bids are the lowest and most responsible for a portion of the supplies contained within the bid list.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of Cunningham Asphalt Paving Inc., Morton Salt, and Altizer Farm Supply, are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids for highway de-icing salt, calcium chloride, and cold mix, and the said as incorporated hereinabove are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That the following companies:

- (1) Cunningham Asphalt Paving Inc., P. O. Box 370, Wheelersburg, OH 45694;
- (2) Morton Salt, 123 N. Wacker Drive, Chicago, IL 60606-1743;
- (3) Altizer Farm Supply, 585 Centerpoint Road, Thurman, OH 45685;

be awarded a contract for line items as per attached bid tabulation. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Cunningham Asphalt Paving Inc., Morton Salt, and Altizer Farm Supply.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
