

ORDINANCE NO. 02009-64

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION AND TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT, IF AWARDED,
FOR 2009 JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT – LAW ENFORCEMENT
(JAG LE) PROGRAM FUNDING**

WHEREAS, the City Manager wishes to apply for a grant for funds through the Justice Assistance Program – Law Enforcement (JAG LE) Program through the Ohio Office of Criminal Justice Services; and

WHEREAS, the determination to apply for such obligation must be made by immediately in order to qualify for such a grant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis desires to apply for said funding; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure in order to provide for the usual daily operations of municipal government and in order to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property of the citizenry of the City of Gallipolis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for the said Justice Assistance Grant – Law Enforcement (JAG LE).


SECTION 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement if the grant is awarded.

SECTION 3: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized and directed to draw her warrants as per the agreement if the grant is awarded; said grant may be up to \$15,000, with a 10% cash match of City funds on total project cost.


SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.


