

ORDINANCE NO. O2009-73

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS
TO VARIOUS ENTITIES FOR COMMUNITY INVESTMENT CONTRIBUTION**

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis City Commission desires to contribute toward various local community entities that assist in improving the community's economic development, tourism and historical and cultural interests; and

WHEREAS, the success of these entities provides numerous benefits to the City of Gallipolis providing a healthy and vital business climate and liberal arts education and opportunities for the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Gallipolis City Commission to help enhance the community's assets; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw her warrants at the direction of the City Manager in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) each to the following five (5) entities: Ariel Theatre, French Art Colony, Gallia County Historical Society, John Gee Black Historical Society and Our House Museum.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
