

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-20

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING "EXHIBIT A",
SECTION III (b), OF ORDINANCE NO. O2013-13,
ESTABLISHING THE GALLIPOLIS
JOB CREATION INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, development and creation of new jobs within the City of Gallipolis is beneficial to the economic well-being and general welfare of the City and its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of City Commission of the City of Gallipolis to create a Job Creation Incentive Program to be applied in accordance with this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to amend Section III(b) of "Exhibit A" of the Job Creation Incentive Program; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That "Exhibit A", Section III (b) which reads as follows:

\$500,000 – 1,500,000	20%	3
\$1,500,001 – 2,250,000	30%	4
\$2,250,001 – 3,000,000	40%	5
\$3,000,001 +	50%	5-10

Tax payments shall not carry forward from one year to the next.

BE, AND HEREBY, IS AMENDED to read as follows:

(b) The City of Gallipolis shall provide a yearly payment to an enterprise up to 50% of the employee's 1% income tax withholdings that are paid to the City of Gallipolis. An enterprise must relocate new jobs to the City of Gallipolis or create "net new jobs."

\$1,500,001 – 2,250,000	50%	4
\$2,250,001 – 3,000,000	50%	5
\$3,000,001 +	50%	5-10

Tax payments shall not carry forward from one year to the next.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
