

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-21

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. O2010-77,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2011-01,
AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. O2011-79,
AMENDING C6(I), COMPENSATION FOR SALARIED EMPLOYEES,
PROJECT DIRECTOR/SAFETY DIRECTOR
AND REPEALING PREVIOUS ORDINANCES SETTING SAID COMPENSATION**

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio wishes to amend Ordinance No. O2010-77, as amended by Ordinance No. O2011-01, as amended by Ordinance No. O2011-79, to change the compensation set for the Project Coordinator/Safety Director; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

Section 1: **That SECTION C6: COMPENSATION FOR SALARIED EMPLOYEES, (I)**, setting compensation for Project Coordinator/Safety Director, which reads as follows:

(1) The Project Coordinator/Safety Director shall work a thirty-two (32) hour week and shall be paid a salary equal to that of the Water Treatment Plant and Water Pollution Control Facility Superintendents prorated to his work week, to wit, four-fifths (4/5) of the Superintendent's salary, payable biweekly, effective November 29, 2010.

BE, AND HEREBY IS, AMENDED to read as follows for compensation for Project Coordinator/Safety Director:

(1) (a) The Project Coordinator/Safety Director shall receive Fifty-four Thousand Four Hundred and Eight Dollars (\$54,408.00) annually, payable biweekly, effective March 25, 2013.

(b) Upon hire, the Project Coordinator/Safety Director shall have credited to his vacation two weeks (80 hours) vacation time.

Section 2: REPEAL OF PREVIOUS ORDINANCES

All previous ordinances setting compensation for Project Coordinator/Safety Director, except Section 7 of Ordinance No. O2003-11 which Ordinance shall remain effective for all employees hired before September 30, 1981, with regard to their longevity increase.

Section 3: SAVINGS CLAUSE.

That nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section E of Ordinance No. 2010-77, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 4: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure and effective March 25, 2013.
