

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-42

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
CHAPTER 376.06, RECREATIONAL VEHICLES,
MAXIMUM CONSECUTIVE DOCKING HOURS,
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis desires to establish guidelines concerning maximum docking hours at the Public Use Area Docks; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Chapter 376.06, Maximum Consecutive Docking Hours, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gallipolis shall be established to read as follows:


376.06 MAXIMUM CONSECUTIVE DOCKING HOURS

It shall be unlawful to dock any recreational vehicle in the Public Use Area Docks for more than seventy-two (72) consecutive hours.


SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
