

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-58

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
HIGHWAY DE-ICING SALT, CALCIUM CHLORIDE, AND COLD MIX**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2012-22A passed by the City Commission on November 20, 2012, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for highway de-icing salt, calcium chloride, and cold mix.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Thursday, September 26, 2013, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the bid of Morton Salt is the lowest and most responsible for highway de-icing salt; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of Morton Salt is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for highway de-icing salt, and the said as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That Morton Salt, 123 N. Wacker Drive, Chicago, IL 60606-1743, be awarded a contract for highway de-icing salt. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.


SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Morton Salt.


SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.


