

ORDINANCE NO. 02013-59

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER  
TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS  
TO PARTICIPATE IN THE  
OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION (OPWC)  
STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR  
LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S)  
AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED  
FOR THE CRUZET/BERGER AVENUE AREA  
SANITARY SEWER LINE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gallipolis is planning to make capital improvements of sanitary sewer line improvements for the Cruzet/Berger Avenue area; and

**WHEREAS**, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


**SECTION 1:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds sanitary sewer line improvements for the Cruzet/Berger Avenue Area Sanitary Sewer Line Improvements Project.


**SECTION 2:** The City Manager is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
