

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-73

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT
WITH COMPMANAGEMENT, INC.,
FOR CONSULTATION AND ADMINISTRATION WITH
RESPECT TO WORKERS' COMPENSATION MATTERS**

WHEREAS, Employer provides workers' compensation benefits to its employees through the State of Ohio Workers' Compensation Fund, administered by the State of Ohio, by the payment of premiums to the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, CompManagement, Inc., provides consultation and administration services with respect to workers' compensation matters; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of contracting with Comp Management for the performance of consultation and administration services with respect to its workers' compensation program; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to designate CompManagement, Inc. as the representative for the City of Gallipolis for consultation and administration with respect to its workers' compensation matters through the Ohio Municipal League – Villages L3 group; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement through the Ohio Municipal League – Villages 3 group with CompManagement, Inc. a Sedgewick CMS Company (CMI), P.O. Box 182412, Columbus, Ohio 43018-2412, as the representative of the City of Gallipolis for consultation and administrative services with respect to the City's workers' compensation matters claims administration services and online claims access starting September 1, 2013 and for a one-year period beginning January 1, 2014 and ending December 31, 2014 for group rating enrollment.

SECTION 2: That the City Auditor shall draw her warrants at the direction of the City Manager in accordance with the terms of the attached Agreement.


SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


