

ORDINANCE NO. O2014-23

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO APPLY, AND THE RURAL COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE PARTNERSHIP (RCAP) TO SUBMIT THE ELECTRONIC APPLICATION, FOR CDBG RESIDENTIAL PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM FUNDING TO THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis desperately needs to complete the Water Pollution Control Facility Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis does not have the funds available within its budget to finance the project, it is imperative that the City seek funding from outside programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commission of the City of Gallipolis:

Section 1. The Gallipolis City Manager is hereby authorized to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency for CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Program funding necessary to finance a portion of the project.


Section 2. The Rural Community Assistance Partnership (RCAP) is hereby authorized to submit the electronic application to the Ohio Development Services Agency for CDBG Residential Public Infrastructure Program funding.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon final passage as an emergency measure.


