ORDINANCE NO. O2014-46

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH KOMAX BUSINESS SYSTEMS FOR THE LEASE OF A PRINTER-SCANNER-COPIER FOR ENGINEERING DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis Ohio desires to lease a printer-scanner-copier for storing, maintaining and developing documents for engineering drawings; and

WHEREAS, after bidding for suitable equipment to lease and Komax Business Systems was the best and lowest bidder; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is directed to enter into an agreement between the City of Gallipolis and Komax Business Systems, for a lease of a printer-copier-scanner for 60 months at the rate of One Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$190.00) per month with a \$1 buyout at the end of the lease.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
