

ORDINANCE NO. O2014-51

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ADOPTING AN ANTI-DISPLACEMENT
AND RELOCATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS**

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis plans to seek funding from the Ohio Development Services Agency to finance a portion of their WPCF Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Development Services Agency regulations require that all grantees have an Anti-Displacement and Relocation Assistance Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: The attached anti-displacement and relocation assistance plan is hereby adopted, and should any of the activities involving the WPCF Improvements include demolition or conversion of low income housing units, the adopted plan will be adhered to.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
