

**ORDINANCE O2014-64**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING  
THE CITY MANAGER  
TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT  
WITH HIGHLAND COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE  
FOR THE HOUSING OF PRISONERS**

**WHEREAS**, the City needs to provide for the boarding of prisoners arrested for or serving sentences for violations of Municipal and State Ordinances within the City of Gallipolis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Highland County Sheriff's Office has provisions for the boarding of prisoners and is willing to provide said service; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gallipolis and Highland County Sheriff's Office wish to enter into contract for the boarding of City prisoners; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


**SECTION 1:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into agreement with Highland County Sheriff's Office for the housing of prisoners as per the attached agreement, "Exhibit A." for the period starting January 1, 2014 and terminating December 31, 2014.


**SECTION 2:** That the City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants as per said agreement, payable to Highland County Sheriff's Office at the direction of the City Manager.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure and retroactive to January 1, 2014.




