

ORDINANCE NO. O2014-75

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO .O2013-27, DECLARING OFFICIAL INTENT WITH RESPECT TO REIMBURSEMENT OF TEMPORARY ADVANCES MADE FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO, TO BE MADE FROM SUBSEQUENT BORROWINGS

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis Municipal Court has issued a Journal Entry (Exhibit A, attached), dated November 5, 2014, ordering that the City of Gallipolis shall not be required to reimburse the Court for the \$32,000 portion of the purchase price of 44 Locust Street, as per their original agreement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis wishes to repeal Ordinance No. O2013-27, declaring official intent with respect to reimbursement of temporary advances made for capital expenditures for the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, to be made from subsequent borrowings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Ordinance No. O2013-27 is hereby repealed.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
