

ORDINANCE NO. O2015-03

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE
CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LETTER OF AGREEMENT
WITH CANADAY CARE LLC FOR
HEALTHCARE SERVICES FOR CITY OF GALLIPOLIS
EMPLOYEES AND ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS**

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of providing additional health care services for full-time employees and elected and appointed officials of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a Letter of Agreement with Elizabeth A. Canaday CNP, Canaday Care LLC, 10 Airport Road, Gallipolis, Ohio 45631 for health care services for full-time employees and elected and appointed officials of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio.

Section 2: That the City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Elizabeth A. Canaday CNP, Canaday Care LLC, 10 Airport Road, Gallipolis, Ohio 45631 for health care services, at the direction of the City Manager, as per the attached Letter of Agreement and schedule of services.


Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect retroactive for the coverage period from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015.
