## ORDINANCE NO. O2015-08

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, DIVISION OF WATERCRAFT, FOR GALLIPOLIS BOATING AND FISHING ACCESS IMPROVEMENTS GRANT

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, represented by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources,

have agreed to provide a boating access improvement project grant to the City of Gallipolis; and WHEREAS, the total estimated cost of the project is \$1,006,975.00 which includes construction, engineering, and advertising costs. The State agrees to pay a maximum of 100% of the estimated project costs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis desires financial assistance under the Ohio Department of Natural Resources program and has received notice of the award of the ODNR grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enter into agreement with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Division of Watercraft, for the Gallipolis Boating and Fishing Access Improvement Project in the amount of \$1,006,975.00.

**SECTION 2:** That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw her warrants under the terms and conditions of said ODNR agreement.

**SECTION 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
