

ORDINANCE NO. O2015-39

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
HIGHWAY DE-ICING SALT, CALCIUM CHLORIDE, AND COLD MIX**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2014-22 passed by the City Commission on November 18, 2014, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for highway de-icing salt, calcium chloride, and cold mix.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Thursday, September 10, 2015, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bids of Cargill Inc. and Shelly Materials are the lowest and most responsible for highway de-icing salt and cold mix.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of Cargill Inc. for de-icing salt and Shelly Materials for cold mix are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids and are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That Cargill Inc., 24950 Country Club Blvd., Suite 450, North Olmsted, OH 44070 and Shelly Materials, 1771 Harmon Avenue, Columbus, OH 43223, be awarded a contract for highway de-icing salt and cold mix. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Cargill Inc. and Shelly Materials.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
