

RESOLUTION NO. R2010-05

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR
ODNR LWCF NATUREWORKS
PUBLIC RECREATION PROGRAM FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
FOR BASKETBALL EQUIPMENT FOR THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS
TED PERRY MEMORIAL FIELD (WATER TREATMENT PLANT)
AND FOR HASKINS PARK**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, Land and Water Conservation Fund, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes, through the State of Ohio NatureWorks Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis desires financial assistance under the Ohio Department of Natural Resources programs and the City of Gallipolis desires to apply for such grants for the basketball equipment for the Ted Perry Memorial Field (Water Treatment Plant) and for Haskins Park; and

WHEREAS, if such application is not made immediately, the City has lost the potential to apply for the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the City of Gallipolis approves filing an application for NatureWorks financial assistance for basketball equipment for the Ted Perry Memorial Field (Water Treatment Plant) and for Haskins Park.

SECTION 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required in order to become eligible for possible funding assistance.


SECTION 3: That the City of Gallipolis does agree to obligate the funds required (\$2,125 of the \$8,500 project) to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and to become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and conditions of said NatureWorks Program.

SECTION 4: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure and shall be retroactive to February 1, 2010.
