

**RESOLUTION NO. R2010-19**

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR  
DEMOLITION AND ASBESTOS ABATEMENT OF THE  
FORMER GALLIPOLIS MUNICIPAL BUILDING  
518 SECOND AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, desires to have the former Gallipolis Municipal Building demolished in order to facilitate the construction of a new municipal building or parking lot; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to request bids for such project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio;


