

RESOLUTION NO. R2014-23

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R2002-41,
A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PHASE 2 OF THE
ALTERNATE ACCESS ROUTE KNOWN AS FARM ROAD**

WHEREAS, the City has been unable, in the twelve years since completion of phase one of Farm Road, to secure sufficient funding to complete the second phase of Farm Road, which was to be built from the road's current terminus at GKN Sinter to Second Avenue; and

WHEREAS, many residents and businesses along the proposed route have expressed their on-going opposition to such a project; and

WHEREAS, funding seems unlikely in the fore-seeable future; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure in order to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property of the citizenry of the City of Gallipolis and in order for the City to provide for the usual daily operations of municipal government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: The City Commission hereby no longer endorses the completion of the second phase of Farm Road to finish its construction from GKN Sinter to Second Avenue.

SECTION 2: That Resolution No. R2002-41 is hereby repealed.


SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
