

ORDINANCE NO. O2013-35

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS
FOR ACTIVE DEPOSITS FOR TREASURY FUNDS
OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, wishes to contract with a financial institution for the services for the active deposits of the Treasury Funds of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the proposals submitted were filed with the City Auditor until 12:00 noon on Wednesday, May 29, 2013, at which time they were duly opened and read for financial services for the active deposits of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1: That Ohio Valley Bank, 420 Third Avenue, Gallipolis, Ohio, being the best and most responsible bid for the financial services required by the City of Gallipolis for its active deposits, be awarded said financial services as per said proposal.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect at the earliest period of time permitted by law.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


