

ORDINANCE NO. O2018-26
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SECTION 539.03
"HASKINS PARK AND CANADAY PARK CLOSED 11:00 P.M. TO 5:00 A.M."
OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS, OHIO

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of promoting the health and welfare of the Citizenry by enforcement of the provisions adopted by these Codified Ordinances (as amended from time to time); and,

WHEREAS, an integral part of the enforcement of said code provisions is the safety and security of the Citizenry; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of instituting additional incentives and safeguards for the prohibition of certain unauthorized uses of Haskins Park and Canaday Park of the City; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 539.03 is hereby established and shall read as follows:

"539.03 HASKINS PARK AND CANADAY PARK CLOSED 11:00 P.M. TO 5:00 A.M.

539.03(A) No person shall be present, congregate, or remain inside Haskins Park or Canaday Park without prior written approval of the City Manager or his agent between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. daily.


539.03(B) No person shall fail to disperse from Haskins Park or Canaday Park at the order of a police officer between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 5:00 A.M. daily.


539.03(C) The penalty for a first violation of 539.03(A) is minor misdemeanor as that term is defined in the Ohio Revised Code. The penalty for subsequent violations of 539.03(A) is a fourth degree misdemeanor as that term is defined in the Ohio Revised Code. Violations of 539.03(B) shall be a fourth degree misdemeanor."

BE AND HEREBY IS ESTABLISHED, AND;


SECTION 2: That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period of time allowed by law.
