

**ORDINANCE NO. O2015-62**

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE  
BOUNDARIES OF THE DOWNTOWN GALLIPOLIS REVITALIZATION DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Gallipolis is desirous of increasing the entertainment, retail, educational, sporting, social, cultural, and arts opportunities for the Citizenry and visitors to the City of Gallipolis; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager, pursuant to Revised Code Section 4301.81, has approved an application for the creation of a Downtown Gallipolis Revitalization District and recommended the same to the City Commission, a copy of said application is attached hereto as Exhibit A; and


**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of the Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

**SECTION 1:** A Downtown Gallipolis Revitalization District is hereby created.


**SECTION 2:** The boundaries of the Downtown Gallipolis Revitalization District shall be described as those areas zoned for Neighborhood Commercial, Office Community Service, Historic Residential District, and Historic Urban Square District which border those Streets from Vine to Sycamore, and those Avenues from First to Fourth as well as the Neighborhood Commercial zone near Vinton Avenue and State Route 160.
