RESOLUTION NO. R2018-11

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, EUGENE GREENE, TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the CITY OF GALLIPOLIS is planning to make capital improvements to 2019 CITY OF GALLIPOLIS improvements, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by CITY OF GALLIPOLIS:

Section 1: The CITY MANAGER, EUGENE GREENE is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The CITY MANAGER, EUGENE GREENE is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be effective upon passage as an emergency measure and retro-active to October 01, 2018.
