

**RESOLUTION NO. R2018-12**

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER  
TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF  
MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES  
FOR USE BY THE CITY IN THE CALENDAR YEAR 2019  
AS HEREIN DESCRIBED**

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to annually authorize the City Manager to bid for the purchase of materials, supplies, equipment and services for use by the City in the calendar year 2019.

**WHEREAS**, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:


**SECTION 1:** That the City Manager of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the purchase of necessary materials, supplies and equipment, and any work or item that would be over the state authorized maximum expenditure.


These will be advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, according to law and the Charter of the City of Gallipolis.

It is necessary to obtain bids and enter into contracts for materials, supplies, equipment, and services for use by the City in the calendar year 2019 in order to obtain the best prices for such items and to insure that said items are available to the City when needed.


**SECTION 2:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
