SECTION 2(C), SETTING EMPLOYEE'S PORTION OF PAYMENT FOR HOSPITALIZATION, MEDICAL AND MAJOR MEDICAL INSURANCE

WHEREAS, the City Commission is desirous of offering hospitalization, medical and major medical insurance coverage to appointed and elected officials and full-time city employees; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Commission to contain costs and reduce expenses for rising health insurance costs where possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Section 2(c) which reads as follows:

- (c) Effective with the first payroll period in January 2018, the cost to be deducted for covered employees shall be as follows:
 - 1) \$ 50.40 per pay Single Coverage Plan
 2) \$142.56 per pay Employee/Spayse Plan
 - 2) \$142.56 per pay Employee/Spouse Plan
 3) \$125.66 per pay Employee/Children Plan
 - 4) \$217.83 per pay Family Plan

BE, AND HEREBY, IS AMENDED to read as follows:

(c) The cost to be deducted for covered employees shall be as follows: Effective with first payroll period in January 2019, each employee shall pay twelve percent (12%) of the monthly cost of health insurance for single plan coverage; each employee having coverage in excess of the single plan shall pay twenty percent (20%) of the cost above the single plan premium.
