

ORDINANCE NO. O2019-34

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
HIGHWAY DE-ICING SALT, CALCIUM CHLORIDE, AND COLD MIX**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2018-12 passed by the City Commission on November 27, 2018, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for highway de-icing salt, calcium chloride, and cold mix.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Thursday, September 26, 2019, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bids of Altizer Farm Supply, Cargill Inc, and Hei-Way LLC are the lowest and most responsible for de-icing salt, calcium chloride and cold mix.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of Altizer Farm Supply for calcium chloride, Cargill Inc. for de-icing salt, and Hei-Way LLC for cold mix, are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids and are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That Altizer Farm Supply, 585 Centerpoint Road, Thurman, OH 45685, Cargill Inc., 24950 Country Club Blvd., Ste 450, North Olmstead, OH 44070, and Hei-Way LLC, 290 North Pike Road, Sarver, PA 16055, be awarded a contract for de-icing salt, calcium chloride and cold mix. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Altizer Farm Supply, Cargill Inc, and Hei-Way LLC.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
