

**ORDINANCE NO. O2020-36****AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR  
THE PAVING OF CITY STREETS**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2019-09, passed by the City Commission on November 19, 2019, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for the paving of City streets.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Friday, September 25, 2020, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of The Shelly Company is the lowest and most responsible bid for the paving of City streets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bid of The Shelly Company, 80 Park Drive, Thornville, Ohio, is hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bid for the paving of City streets, and the said as incorporated hereinabove is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to The Shelly Company for 30% of the project cost and the remaining 70% to be paid by the Ohio Public Works Commission.

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage as an emergency measure.
