ORDINANCE NO. O2020-38
AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY
MANAGER TO ENTER INTO THE FINAL AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO
FOR THE STATE ROUTE 588 SLIP REPAIR

WHEREAS, State Route 588 within the City of Gallipolis is in need of repair due to a landslide; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary to expedite highway projects and promote highway safety for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

SECTION I - Project Description

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of September, 2020, the City of Gallipolis enacted legislation proposing cooperation with the Director of Transportation for the described project:

The project consists of a landslide repair along S.R. 588 located at Mile Post 11.10, including the removal of spoils, laying back and reclaiming the slope, and repair of the roadway surface, lying within the Village of Gallipolis; and

SECTION II - Cooperation Statement

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The Village agrees to assume and bear one Hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of the improvement within the village limits, less the amount of Federal-Aid and State funds set aside by the Director of Transportation for the financing of this improvement from funds allocated by the Federal Highway Administration, U. S. Department of Transportation.

In view of the fact that the City of Gallipolis' share of the project is now estimated in the amount of **Zero and - - - - 00/100 Dollars, (\$0.00)**, therefore, the Village of the City of Gallipolis will not be required to deposit any funds at this time. The City of Gallipolis' ultimate share of the cost will be determined when final actual costs and allocations are determined.

WHEREAS, The Director of Transportation has approved said legislation proposing cooperation and has caused to be made plans and specifications and an estimate of cost and expense for improving the above described highway and has transmitted copies of same to the City of Gallipolis; and

WHEREAS, The City of Gallipolis desires the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Gallipolis, of Gallia County, Ohio

That the City of Gallipolis hereby requests the Director of Transportation to proceed with the aforesaid highway improvement. The City of Gallipolis will transmit to the Director of Transportation a fully executed copy of this Ordinance.

SECTION III - Authority to Sign

That the City of Gallipolis enter into a contract with the State, and that the **City Manager** be, and is hereby authorized to execute said contract for improving the described project.

SECTION IV - Effective Dates

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
