**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING
THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW MUNICIPAL BUILDING
TO HOUSE THE GALLIPOLIS MUNICIPAL COURT
AND MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICES**

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis City Commission desires to build a new Municipal Building to house the Gallipolis Municipal Court and Municipal Law Enforcement Offices; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to request bids for such project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio;



SECTION 2: That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.


