## **RESOLUTION NO. R2011-21**

## AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE STREET NAME OF MOUND HILL ROAD FOR THE **NEW ACCESS ROAD FOR** MOUND HILL CEMETERY AND FORTIFICATION HILL

WHEREAS, the City constructed a new access road to Mound Hill Cemetery and Fortification Hill necessary due to a slip on the previous access road; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission wishes to name all of that portion of the newly constructed road beginning from State Route 141 (Portsmouth Road), and terminating at the entrance of the Cemetery; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to name the road "Mound Hill Road" for historic purposes and to ensure the name for the road is consistent for its entire length; and

WHEREAS, there being no other road or street with the same name; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the name for the new access road beginning at State Route 141 (Portsmouth Road) and terminating at the entrance of the cemetery shall be Mound Hill Road.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
