RESOLUTION NO. R2012-24

AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. R2010-12, AND APPOINTING RONNIE LYNCH AS ACTING CITY MANAGER IN THE ABSENCE OR INCAPACITY OF THE CITY MANAGER

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, is desirous of appointing Ronnie G. Lynch as Acting City Manager whenever the City Manager is absent or incapacitated; and

WHEREAS, if Ronnie Lynch is absent or incapacitated the City Manager may designate an Acting City Nanager; and

WHEREAS, the Gallipolis City Commission desires to give the Acting City Manager all the authority and power vested in the position of City Manager including the power to sign all documents required to be signed by the City Manager; and

WHEREAS, due to scheduled or unavoidable absences, it is necessary to have an Acting City Manager appointed to maintain city services and current obligations; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure in order to provide for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property of the citizenry of the City of Gallipolis and in order for the City to provide for the usual daily operations of municipal government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That Ronnie Lynch is hereby appointed as Acting City Manager for the City of Gallipolis in the absence or incapacity of the City Manager. During such absence or incapacity, the Acting City Manager shall have all the authority vested in the City Manager by the Charter of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio.

SECTION 2: That Resolution No. R2010-12 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
