

RESOLUTION NO. R2012-25

**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE AMOUNTS AND RATES
AS DETERMINED BY THE BUDGET COMMISSION OF GALLIA COUNTY
AND AUTHORIZING THE NECESSARY TAX LEVIES
AND CERTIFYING THEM TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR**

WHEREAS, this Commission, in accordance with the provisions of law, has previously adopted a Tax Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year January 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Commission of Gallia County, Ohio, has certified its action thereon to this Commission together with an estimate by the County Auditor of the rate of each tax necessary to be levied by this Commission, and what part thereof is without, and what part within, the ten mill levy limitation; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the amounts and rates, as determined by the Budget Commission in its certification, be and the same are hereby accepted; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there be and is hereby levied on the tax duplicate of said City the rate of each tax necessary to be levied within and without the ten mill limitation as follows:


1.90 mills (inside 10 mill limit) fee producing One Hundred Thirty-nine and Seven Hundred Forty-four and 43/100 Dollars (\$139,744.43) and 2.00 mills (outside 10 mill limit) fee producing One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand Three Hundred Twenty-nine and 54/100 Dollars (\$124,329.54) fee.

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
