## **RESOLUTION NO. R2013-05**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF GALLIPOLIS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION PROGRAM FUNDING FOR THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis needs to complete improvements to their water pollution control facility, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis does not have the funds available within its budget to finance the project, it is imperative that the city seek funding from outside programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Resolution as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The City Manager is hereby authorized to submit an application for Appalachian Regional Commission funding necessary to finance a portion of the project.

**SECTION 2:** This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure for the general health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of Gallipolis.

**SECTION 3:** This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage as an emergency measure.
