

ORDINANCE NO. O2016-38

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR THE GALLIPOLIS RIVERFRONT IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for the Gallipolis Riverfront Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Thursday, July 28, 2016. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the bids are being evaluated and the City Commission desires to award the contract based upon the recommendation of the engineering consulting firm of E. L. Robinson, Ironton, Ohio, for the Gallipolis Riverfront Improvements Project; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1: That the bid be awarded to the firm of Pullins Excavating, 33334 St. Rt. 833, Pomeroy, Ohio 45769, as recommended by the consulting engineering firm of E. L. Robinson, for the Gallipolis Riverfront Improvements Project in the amount of \$792,250.00.


SECTION 2: That the City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Pullins Excavating, not to exceed the amount in their submitted bid for Seven Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Two Hundred Fifty (\$792,250.00).


SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.
