

ORDINANCE NO. O2017-09

**AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE ACCEPTING AND REJECTING BIDS FOR
CHEMICALS AND QUICKLIME**

Pursuant to Resolution No. R2016-05 passed by the City Commission on December 6, 2016, the City Manager advertised in the Gallipolis Daily Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, for chemicals and quicklime.

The bids submitted were filed with the City Manager until 12:00 Noon, Wednesday, February 22, 2017, at which time they were duly opened and read. All of said bids are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREAS, the bid of four of the seven companies that submitted competitive bids are the lowest and most responsible bid for a portion of the supplies contained within the bid list.

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio, that the bids of the companies listed in Section 1 are hereby declared the lowest and most responsible bids for chemicals and quicklime, and the said as incorporated hereinabove are hereby accepted.

SECTION 1: That the following companies:

- (1) Brenntag Mid-South Inc., 319 First Street North, St. Albans, WV 25177;
- (2) Bonded Chemicals, 2645 Charter Street, Columbus, Ohio 43228;
- (3) Greer Industries Inc., 598 Canyon Road, Morgantown, WV 26508;
- (4) C. I. Thornburg Co. Inc., 4034 Altizer Avenue, Huntington, WV 25705;

be awarded a contract for line items as per attached bid tabulation. The total contract amount is not to exceed budgetary funding.

SECTION 2: The City Auditor is authorized to draw her warrants on the City of Gallipolis, Ohio, payable to Brenntag Mid-South Inc, Bonded Chemicals, Greer Industries Inc., and C. I. Thornburg Co..

SECTION 3: All other bids and parts of bids are hereby rejected.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect when contract begins on April 1, 2017.
