## **ORDINANCE NO. 02017-37**

## AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH USI INSURANCE SERVICES (PEP) FOR GENERAL LIABILITY AND PROPERTY INSURANCE

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City of Gallipolis to contract for insurance coverage for general liability and property; and

WHEREAS, USI Insurance Services (PEP) has the best and most responsible quote for said insurance; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended in writing the passage of this Ordinance as an emergency measure as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and property and in order to provide for the usual operations of the municipal departments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the City Manager of the City of Gallipolis is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with USI Insurance Services (PEP) to provide insurance coverage for the City in accordance with a proposal for coverage from October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018, which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw her warrants at the direction of the City Manager to USI Insurance Services (PEP), c/o Saunders Insurance Agency, 437 Second Avenue, Gallipolis, Ohio 45631, for a total amount of Seventy Thousand Two Hundred Forty-Seven and 00/100 Dollars (\$70,247); in three payments of \$23,415.67 each, due October 1, 2017, January 1, 2018, and April 1, 2018.

**Section 3:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon passage as an emergency measure and retro-active to October 1, 2017.
