RESOLUTION NO. R2022-08

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT TETRA TECH AS THE ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING FIRM TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE WITH SECURING STATE GRANTS FOR THE ASSESSMENT, CLEANUP, OR REDEVELOPMENT OF BROWNFIELD PROPERTIES, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL REMEDIATION, RISK ASSESSMENTS, COMMUNITY OUTREACH, AND OTHER ENVIRONMENT OR PLANNING COMPONENTS OF GRANT WHICH FUNDING IS SECURED.

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio has identified the need for funding for assessment, cleanup, demolition and redevelopment of certain properties located within the City of Gallipolis, Ohio;

WHEREAS, the state of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Development, has Program Year 2022 (PY2022) funds available as part of the Ohio Department of Development Brownfield Remediation Program and Demolition and Site Revitalization Program;

WHEREAS, the City of Gallipolis may be eligible to receive Brownfield Remediation Program grant funds and Demolition and Site Revitalization Program funds if applied for,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Commission of the City of Gallipolis, Ohio:

SECTION 1: The City shall accept Tetra Tech Inc. as the environmental consulting firm to provide assistance with: (a) securing state grants for the assessment, cleanup, or redevelopment of Brownfield's properties, and (b) implementation of environmental remediation, risk assessments, community outreach, and other environmental or planning components of grants for which funding is secured.

SECTION 2: The City Manager of the City of Gallipolis, State of Ohio is hereby authorized and empowered to enter into contracts with the Tetra Tech Inc., as well as, Ohio Department of Development Brownfield Remediation Program and Demolition and Site Revitalization Program as necessary to complete the above described projects.

SECTION 3: If assistance is approved, that all involved will comply with the required assurances of the grant.

SECTION 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest time as allowed by law.
